



CALL FOR COMMENTS:

APPLICATIONS FOR RENEWAL OF LIQUOR LICENCE FOR 2023

IN TERMS OF SECTION 64 OF THE WESTERN CAPE LIQUOR ACT, 2008 (THE ACT)

DATE OF PUBLICATION: 07 SEPTEMBER 2022

COMMENT DEADLINE: 14 SEPTEMBER 2022

On 06 September 2022, the WCLA received the following applications for renewal of liquor licences, which form part of the 116 licences not capable of automatic renewal for 2023. These 116 licensees have failed to comply with the conditions of their licence, the Act or a compliance notice, and are therefore required to apply for the renewal of the licence.

To date, 40 applications have been received. The remaining licensees have until 30 September 2022 to lodge applications for renewal of their licence for 2023.

Comments should include:

1. Name & address of licensed premises
2. Commentor's name, address, contact numbers and ID / registration number (information will be handled with privacy in line with the Protection of Personal Information Act)
3. Full reasons for comments, based on facts with dates, times and examples of incidents
4. Supporting evidence where possible (photos, video etc.)
