

LIQUOR LICENSING FEE INCREASES PUBLISHED FOR COMMENT

The Western Cape Government has published a draft amendment to the <u>Western Cape Liquor</u> <u>Regulations</u> in the Provincial Gazette, including proposed amendments to liquor licensing fees. A 30day period for public comment has now commenced.

Liquor licensing fees are revised annually ahead of the liquor licence renewal period. Any person or organisation wishing to comment must submit comments in writing before or on **16 September 2023** to the Department of Police Oversight and Community Safety (full details below). Following a review of all comments and inputs received, the final amendment to the regulations will be Gazetted, confirming the new licensing fees.
