



CALL FOR COMMENTS:

APPLICATIONS FOR RENEWAL OF LIQUOR LICENCE FOR 2024

IN TERMS OF SECTION 64 OF THE WESTERN CAPE LIQUOR ACT, 2008 (THE ACT)

DATE OF PUBLICATION: 14 SEPTEMBER 2023

COMMENT DEADLINE: 21 SEPTEMBER 2023

The WCLA received the following application for renewal of a liquor licence. The licensed premises is not capable of automatic renewal for 2024. The licensee have failed to comply with the conditions of their licence, the Act and/or a compliance notice and are therefore required to apply for the renewal of the licence.

The licensee must apply in the prescribed form for the renewal of the licence by no later than **30 September 2023**. If the licensee make application after 30 September 2023 but before 31 December 2023, the licensee may apply in writing to the Liquor Licensing Tribunal for condonation of late submission of the application.

Comments should include:

1. Name & address of licensed premises
2. Commentor's name, address, contact numbers and ID / registration number (information will be handled with privacy in line with the Protection of Personal Information Act)
3. Full reasons for comments, based on facts with dates, times and examples of incidents
4. Supporting evidence where possible (photos, video etc.)
